

# Certified Environmental Practitioner (CEnvP) Scheme

## CEnvP Heritage Specialist Certification



### About

The CEnvP Scheme was established in 2004 and is open to all persons who meet the criteria of verified experience, ethical conduct and competence, regardless of membership or group affiliations, in accordance with ISO17024 “Conformity assessment – General requirements for bodies operating certification of persons.”

### CEnvP Heritage Specialisation

The Heritage specialisation does not differentiate between ‘types’ of heritage professional, Applications are based on an individuals specific skills and role within the heritage management community. CEnvP Heritage Specialists include heritage professionals that work in history, heritage conservation, Aboriginal cultural heritage, historical and built heritage, anthropology, archaeological science and archaeology.

A Heritage Specialist demonstrates they are competent to design, lead, implement and report on investigative studies and assessments relating to the cultural and historical values that might be recognised in a place, landscape or setting.

### Eligibility

To apply to become a CEnvP Heritage specialist, you will need:

- A degree or postgraduate degree in archaeology, anthropology, history, heritage architecture, earth sciences, geography, environmental science, planning or surveying, involving studies in Australian and /or New Zealand contexts.
- 10 years FTE experience in the functional areas of heritage management or research in Australian and/or New Zealand contexts or landscapes.
- Evidence the candidate is a respected, competent, ethical and active member of the profession. This includes including nomination by 3 respected environmental professionals, a detailed CV, reports, publications, citations, conference/seminar presentations, etc.
- Evidence of an ongoing commitment to training and professional improvement (CPD).
- A signed and witnessed statement of claim covering the accuracy of the materials provided to the Certification Board.
